

RED-WINGED BLACKBIRD

Spends a quarter of daylight hours guarding its nest.

GREATEST THREAT

Red-winged Blackbirds eat insects during nesting. Pesticides used on farmland have reduced the blackbirds' sources of food.



HOW CAN YOU HELP?

Eliminate the use of pesticides in your lawn or yard.



Red-winged Blackbird numbers are stable and even increasing because of milder winters.
